For the last six years, I have enjoyed the pleasure and privilege of being an active Trustee of the Society. I am a senior lawyer at the Government Legal Department and a part-time Deputy District Judge sitting in Sussex. I endeavour to contribute my broad legal experience to my role as Council member and throughout my tenure, I have enthusiastically contributed my expertise at every opportunity.

Over the years, I have been consulted on an extremely diverse range of legal issues on an ad hoc basis and have advised on issues ranging from personal injury, public and occupiers' liability, commercial contracts, property matters, employment law, regulatory, compliance and company law. I have found this challenging but enormously rewarding and I hope to continue in this role for the next three years.

It is my hope that the former will, ultimately, facilitate greater investment in the latter.
