

## **Michelham Priory site information for schools**

**Parking** – We have a large coach and car park. Coaches are asked to park beyond the mill.

**Toilets** – There are toilets (including disabled facilities) sited by the barn.

**Physical Access** - Please discuss with the education officer when booking if you have any access needs. Workshops are normally held upstairs in the Gatehouse. Please let the Education Officer know if any of your group have problems with mobility, so that another venue can be arranged

**Lunch** – Lunches can be eaten outside in fine weather and there is a picnic area outside the Dovecote shop. If the weather is poor, lunches can be eaten inside the barn or under the barn eaves. If it is felt that students need to have a run-around, our Iron Age activity and picnic area is ideal; although it is a ten minute walk. It would be appreciated if you could bring a bin bag to collect up rubbish after your picnics.

**Shop** – The Dovecote shop has a good selection of reasonably priced goods for school visitors. Please ensure that no more than 10 students visit the shop at any one time, and that they are well supervised. If preferred, visitors can take advantage of our pre-paid goody bags.
