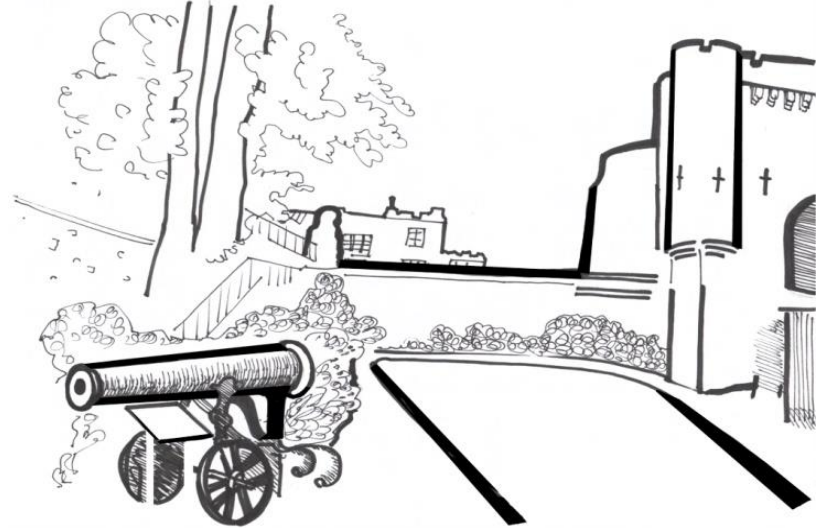


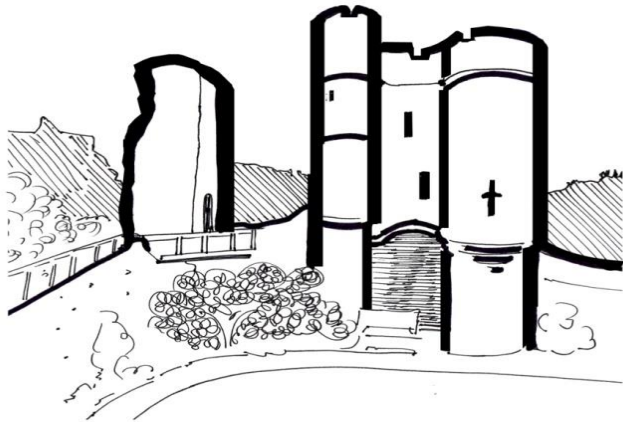
Simple Guide to Lewes Castle



Buy your ticket in the Museum and go through the gate into the gun garden.



This is called the Gun Garden. There used to be a steep ditch here below the high castle walls.



From here you can see the remains of the entrance to the castle. The towers are part of the Barbican gateway. This was built later as an extra defence.



From here you can look across Lewes. You can also see the flat area which was the bailey of the Castle where people worked. Beyond that is the other motte or hill but there is no longer any building on top of this.

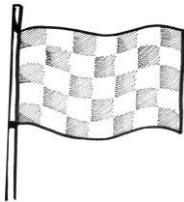
Simple Guide to Lewes Castle



This is the remains of the shell keep. There used to be a high wall all the way around. From here the guards would look out. There were rooms for the important people and you can still find a fireplace.



You can go into the South Tower and look out across Lewes to the remains of the priory and the flood plain towards the sea.



You can climb up spiral steps to the top of the south tower and see if the flag is flying. You can see a long way from the top.



Return to the bottom to listen to the soundscape or visit the museum. You can go across the walkway to the barbican tower too.
