This film shows on a screen. The room can be dark. There is a model of Lewes under the screen.



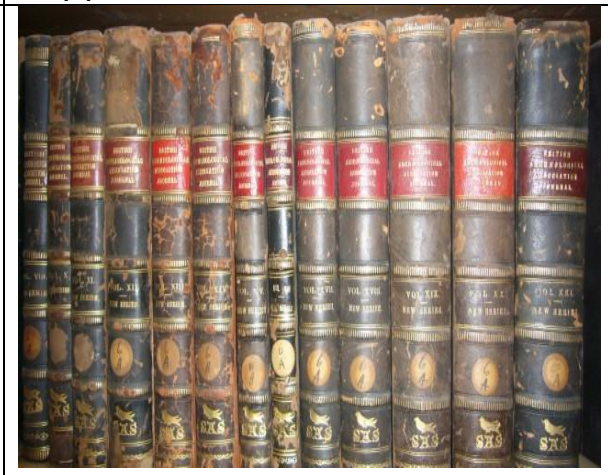
There is a tapestry that tells the story of the Battle of Lewes which happened in 1264.
