Time commitment:	Our volunteering opportunities in this role cover Monday – Sunday, morning and afternoon, so hopefully there will be a time that works for you. Our AM shift is: 11:00 – 14:00 Our PM shift is: 14:00 – 17:00 We are fairly flexible in terms of time commitment, and ask for a general minimum commitment of 1 shift a week (3 hours). If the times stated above do not work for you, or if you have any questions about time commitment generally, then please do not hesitate to get in touch.

We are looking for friendly individuals with a passion for history to come and join our tour guide team. As a tour guide you will help us to deliver guided visits in a number of ways, from delivering tours to visiting groups, to being a friendly presence around the sites answering ad-hoc questions from the public, and helping to run drop-in workshops during holiday periods.

What you'll be doing:

- Providing guided tours across our Lewes sites for visiting groups.
- Providing ad-hoc tours, short talks in the museum and answering questions for members of the public.
- Being a friendly welcoming SAS presence across our sites.
- There may also be opportunity to assist in ad-hoc tasks around the site as required.
- Most importantly, you'll be helping us to preserve and promote the incredible history and stories of our sites.
