BREATHTAKING HISTORIC SUSSEX WEDDING VENUE



Imagine a historic Tudor mansion set amidst seven glorious acres of grounds tucked away behind a Medieval gatehouse and moat?


In a stunning part of the East Sussex countryside, lies the beautiful Michelham Priory which has all this and more including its Elizabethan Barn, just perfect for wedding receptions. The barn can host up to 130 guests for a wedding breakfast and party, has a spectacular vaulted, beamed ceiling filled fairy lights, a bar and both a courtyard garden at the front and private lawns overlooking the moat behind.

The extensive grounds on the estate include a kitchen, physic and medieval herb garden, orchard, formal and informal lawns and wilder areas that are rich in biodiversity.

Michelham Priory has a wedding licence for civil ceremonies allowing couples to choose from a range of locations from the Priory Chamber, in the Tudor house itself (up to 60 guests), the Elizabethan Great Barn or even on the lawns for an alfresco affair.

THE GREAT BARN

STUNNING GRADE I LISTED OAK BEAMED ELIZABETHAN BARN



Michelham Priory's stunning Grade I listed Elizabethan Barn has a breathtaking vaulted ceiling with original oak beams which are swagged throughout with beautiful fairy lights. The perfect depiction of a Sussex barn, it has glass-fronted windows and doors looking onto a private courtyard on one side with pretty festoon lights and outside seating, and its own private walled garden on the other perfect for lawn games and watching the sun set over the moat, drink in hand. The Barn is ideal for ceremonies and receptions of up to 130.

CEREMONIES

Michelham Priory is a licensed venue and so as well as inside spaces The Elizabethan Barn and Prior's Chamber, it is also possible to host an al fresco ceremony. Imagine saying "I Do" beneath the apple orchard, or on the formal lawns in front of the House or the private lawns behind the Elizabethan Barn?

RECEPTIONS

Michelham Priory can host wedding receptions of up to 130 seated guests.

WINTER WEDDINGS

We offers weddings all year round. The Great Barn includes a heating system, so is perfect for winter weddings.

FOOD AND DRINK

There are a choice of approved caterers. There is no corkage fee.

SMALLER WEDDINGS

Ceremonies, drinks and wedding photographs for smaller weddings for up to 60 can also be hosted in the Tudor Priory itself.







ACCESS INFORMATION



ACCESS

If you have booked Michelham Priory on a Saturday, you will have access from 9am on Friday morning to set up and until Sunday 4pm to clear. Cars can be left overnight in the designated area, but should be collected by midday on Sunday.

For weddings which fall on days other than a Saturday, please liaise with our Wedding Coordinator on arrangements.

GETTING HERE

Michelham Priory is located in a small village called Lower Dicker. Located near the A22, Michelham is a short distance from Polegate and can be accessed via Michelham Priory road.

The main line trains from London and Brighton go direct to Polegate and Eastbourne Station and these stations are within 10/15 minutes of the venue.



USEFUL INFORMATION

PRICING

Michelham Priory has flexible pricing dependent on when you book. Prices start at £4000 for midweek weddings, with a typical weekend wedding around £6000. Exclusive hire of the whole estate is possible by arrangement. The hire period covers Friday to Sunday to allow for generous set up and clear down times. Please note that should you wish to host additional events at Michelham Priory over your wedding weekend, this may be subject to additional fees so discuss with the Wedding Coordinator.

FIRE SAFETY

We ask that you take note of where the fire exits and fire extinguishers are placed and are familiar with the fire evacuation policy which is exhibited in the buildings.

CLEAR UP

We would ask that you and your suppliers remove all rubbish and waste from the site and that the areas you have booked are left clear and tidy so that you don't forfeit your cleaning deposit. Clients are responsible for their own rubbish and recycling. Please note that confetti cannons are not permitted anywhere on the estate and only biodegradable confetti should be used.
