Main purpose of the role:	To welcome guests to Fishbourne Roman Palace

The Palace at Fishbourne is an exciting example of our Romano-British history and houses the remains of the largest Roman Villa in Northern Europe. The Palace was discovered in the 1960s and the museum displays some of the original artefacts discovered by the archaeologists. Some of the remains of the building, which was probably larger than Buckingham Palace, can still be seen, including some of the amazing mosaics, and the grounds reflect the large formal gardens that were enjoyed by the Palace's occupants.

We are looking for people who would love to know more the Palace including its discovery, what the Palace may have looked like when it was built sometime between AD 75 and 80, more about the probable owner, a client king called Tiberius Claudius Togidubnus, and consider how the occupants lived and worked before the Palace was destroyed by fire sometime in the third century. If this is you, and you would like to share the story of the Palace with others, we would love to hear from you.

What you will be doing:

- Welcome guests to the Palace including processing admission tickets (including gift aid) and promoting membership of Sussex Past.
- Make the visit to the Palace a memorable one for our guests by being able to answer their
 questions and helping them make the most of their visit by highlighting key areas of interest.
- Help bring the story of the Palace to life by leading/supporting tours, hosting /supporting special events and even dressing up as a Roman soldier.
- Help guests take home a memento of their visit by promoting our gift shop.
- Contribute to the long-term planning objectives of the Palace by making suggestions on how we can continue to improve the visitor experience.
- Most importantly, you'll be helping us to preserve and celebrate this historic site for today's generation and those to come.
