We are seeking volunteers with previous practical experience of undertaking one or more property management functions. With experience across one or more trades such as carpentry, plumbing, electricals, exterior decorator etc.

You will contribute to and deliver parts of the maintenance programme for the property and ensure that the property is maintained to a high standard. Including remedial works and regular routine maintenance

A good understanding of health and safety legislation is required and how these are applied to property maintenance plus a good understanding of property security.

You will help with preparing the property for events and functions e.g. erecting marquees, setting out chairs and tables, lighting and signage. And post-event tear-down.

You will help to implement Health and Safety measures across the property ensuring that the property is operated in a safe manner with respect to all users (visitors, staff, volunteers and contractors).

From time to time, you may be asked to conduct risk assessments and review procedures as necessary in consultation with co-volunteers.

Please note that some maintenance volunteer tasks might involve manual lifting and handling and may involve ongoing physical effort, working at heights, in confined spaces and exposure to chemical substances on occasions.
